Five-module course map

Module	Active evidence to produce
1. network layers	Explain the central idea, complete an application, diagnose one plausible error, and connect it to the next module.
2. IP addressing and routing	Explain the central idea, complete an application, diagnose one plausible error, and connect it to the next module.
3. transport protocols	Explain the central idea, complete an application, diagnose one plausible error, and connect it to the next module.
4. application protocols	Explain the central idea, complete an application, diagnose one plausible error, and connect it to the next module.
5. performance and security	Explain the central idea, complete an application, diagnose one plausible error, and connect it to the next module.

Reliable learning method

trace a message across layers, inspect headers, calculate delay or throughput, test connectivity, and localize failure

Representative application

Diagnose a failed web request by separating name resolution, routing, transport, encryption, and application response.

Weekly study cycle

1. Preview the objective and write two questions. 2. Attend or engage and capture decisions rather than every sentence. 3. Reconstruct the main idea within 24 hours. 4. Complete independent practice. 5. Analyze the first unsupported move on each error. 6. Use feedback. 7. Schedule a delayed mixed recheck.

Self-check before moving on

Can you explain the idea without notes, complete a fresh task, detect a near-miss, verify the result, and state a limitation? Watch especially for: treating every connection failure as one problem or confusing bandwidth, latency, loss, and throughput.

What to save

a packet or protocol trace with calculations, diagnosis, and security notes

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
