Five-module course map

Module	Active evidence to produce
1. Earth materials	Explain the central idea, complete an application, diagnose one plausible error, and connect it to the next module.
2. plate tectonics	Explain the central idea, complete an application, diagnose one plausible error, and connect it to the next module.
3. geologic time	Explain the central idea, complete an application, diagnose one plausible error, and connect it to the next module.
4. weather and climate	Explain the central idea, complete an application, diagnose one plausible error, and connect it to the next module.
5. water and surface processes	Explain the central idea, complete an application, diagnose one plausible error, and connect it to the next module.

Reliable learning method

identify evidence and scale, reconstruct processes, use maps or cross sections, compare rates, and distinguish weather from climate

Representative application

Interpret a geologic cross section and justify the relative sequence of events using stated principles.

Weekly study cycle

1. Preview the objective and write two questions. 2. Attend or engage and capture decisions rather than every sentence. 3. Reconstruct the main idea within 24 hours. 4. Complete independent practice. 5. Analyze the first unsupported move on each error. 6. Use feedback. 7. Schedule a delayed mixed recheck.

Self-check before moving on

Can you explain the idea without notes, complete a fresh task, detect a near-miss, verify the result, and state a limitation? Watch especially for: treating slow change as no change or confusing correlation in Earth records with a complete causal explanation.

What to save

an Earth-system interpretation with map or section, timeline, evidence, process, and uncertainty

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
