Five-module course map

Module	Active evidence to produce
1. health history	Explain the central idea, complete an application, diagnose one plausible error, and connect it to the next module.
2. vital signs	Explain the central idea, complete an application, diagnose one plausible error, and connect it to the next module.
3. systematic physical assessment	Explain the central idea, complete an application, diagnose one plausible error, and connect it to the next module.
4. documentation	Explain the central idea, complete an application, diagnose one plausible error, and connect it to the next module.
5. clinical communication and safety	Explain the central idea, complete an application, diagnose one plausible error, and connect it to the next module.

Reliable learning method

prepare and obtain consent, use approved technique, compare findings with context, document objectively, and escalate according to protocol

Representative application

Organize a simulated assessment and distinguish observed data, patient report, interpretation, and required follow-up.

Weekly study cycle

1. Preview the objective and write two questions. 2. Attend or engage and capture decisions rather than every sentence. 3. Reconstruct the main idea within 24 hours. 4. Complete independent practice. 5. Analyze the first unsupported move on each error. 6. Use feedback. 7. Schedule a delayed mixed recheck.

Self-check before moving on

Can you explain the idea without notes, complete a fresh task, detect a near-miss, verify the result, and state a limitation? Watch especially for: jumping from one finding to a diagnosis or documenting interpretation as if it were direct observation.

What to save

a supervised assessment record with technique checklist, objective findings, communication, and reflection

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
