Five-module course map

Module	Active evidence to produce

4. nervous and muscular systems	Explain the central idea, complete an application, diagnose one plausible error, and connect it to the next module.

Reliable learning method

locate the structure, describe relationships, trace a physiological variable, apply feedback logic, and predict dysfunction carefully

Representative application

Trace a reflex pathway from stimulus to response and explain the roles of sensory, integrative, and motor components.

Weekly study cycle

1. Preview the objective and write two questions. 2. Attend or engage and capture decisions rather than every sentence. 3. Reconstruct the main idea within 24 hours. 4. Complete independent practice. 5. Analyze the first unsupported move on each error. 6. Use feedback. 7. Schedule a delayed mixed recheck.

Self-check before moving on

Can you explain the idea without notes, complete a fresh task, detect a near-miss, verify the result, and state a limitation? Watch especially for: memorizing labels without orientation, relationships, mechanism, or homeostatic consequence.
