Examines learner variability, disability, access, universal design, collaboration, legal context, and belonging.

Five-module course map

Module	Active evidence to produce
1. learner variability	Explain the central idea, complete an application, diagnose one plausible error, and connect it to the next module.
2. universal design for learning	Explain the central idea, complete an application, diagnose one plausible error, and connect it to the next module.
3. accessible instruction	Explain the central idea, complete an application, diagnose one plausible error, and connect it to the next module.
4. individualized supports	Explain the central idea, complete an application, diagnose one plausible error, and connect it to the next module.
5. collaboration and belonging	Explain the central idea, complete an application, diagnose one plausible error, and connect it to the next module.

Reliable learning method

identify barrier in the environment or task, preserve the learning goal, offer multiple access routes, collaborate, and monitor evidence

Representative application

Redesign a lesson to improve sensory, language, executive, and participation access without lowering the central learning target.

Weekly study cycle

1. Preview the objective and write two questions. 2. Attend or engage and capture decisions rather than every sentence. 3. Reconstruct the main idea within 24 hours. 4. Complete independent practice. 5. Analyze the first unsupported move on each error. 6. Use feedback. 7. Schedule a delayed mixed recheck.

Self-check before moving on

Can you explain the idea without notes, complete a fresh task, detect a near-miss, verify the result, and state a limitation? Watch especially for: locating the entire problem within the learner or assuming one accommodation works for everyone.

What to save

an accessibility review with barrier analysis, redesigned materials, support plan, learner voice, and progress evidence

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
