Five-module course map

5. culture and context	Explain the central idea, complete an application, diagnose one plausible error, and connect it to the next module.

Reliable learning method

define the learning target and context, examine evidence, compare theories, design support, and monitor response without diagnosing

Representative application

Analyze why a learner struggles by separating prior knowledge, task design, practice, motivation, language, and environmental access.

Weekly study cycle

1. Preview the objective and write two questions. 2. Attend or engage and capture decisions rather than every sentence. 3. Reconstruct the main idea within 24 hours. 4. Complete independent practice. 5. Analyze the first unsupported move on each error. 6. Use feedback. 7. Schedule a delayed mixed recheck.

Self-check before moving on

Can you explain the idea without notes, complete a fresh task, detect a near-miss, verify the result, and state a limitation? Watch especially for: treating age averages, learning styles, or one observed behavior as a fixed diagnosis.

What to save

a learner-support analysis with evidence, theory comparison, strategy, progress indicator, and ethical limit

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
