Five-module course map

Module	Active evidence to produce
1. word parts	Explain the central idea, complete an application, diagnose one plausible error, and connect it to the next module.
2. anatomical terms	Explain the central idea, complete an application, diagnose one plausible error, and connect it to the next module.
3. diagnostic and procedural language	Explain the central idea, complete an application, diagnose one plausible error, and connect it to the next module.
4. medication and laboratory language	Explain the central idea, complete an application, diagnose one plausible error, and connect it to the next module.
5. safe abbreviation use	Explain the central idea, complete an application, diagnose one plausible error, and connect it to the next module.

Reliable learning method

segment the term, define each component, reconstruct meaning, verify pronunciation and context, and avoid unsupported inference

Representative application

Decode an unfamiliar term into word parts, then verify how its meaning changes with body system or procedure context.

Weekly study cycle

1. Preview the objective and write two questions. 2. Attend or engage and capture decisions rather than every sentence. 3. Reconstruct the main idea within 24 hours. 4. Complete independent practice. 5. Analyze the first unsupported move on each error. 6. Use feedback. 7. Schedule a delayed mixed recheck.

Self-check before moving on

Can you explain the idea without notes, complete a fresh task, detect a near-miss, verify the result, and state a limitation? Watch especially for: guessing a diagnosis from one word part or using unsafe abbreviations without institutional policy.

What to save

a terminology notebook with word analysis, context sentence, pronunciation check, and correction log

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
