Five-module course map

Reliable learning method

define objective and stakeholders, diagnose context, compare alternatives, choose, implement with roles, and evaluate

Representative application

Diagnose a team performance problem by separating structure, incentives, skills, information, and leadership assumptions.

Weekly study cycle

1. Preview the objective and write two questions. 2. Attend or engage and capture decisions rather than every sentence. 3. Reconstruct the main idea within 24 hours. 4. Complete independent practice. 5. Analyze the first unsupported move on each error. 6. Use feedback. 7. Schedule a delayed mixed recheck.

Self-check before moving on

Can you explain the idea without notes, complete a fresh task, detect a near-miss, verify the result, and state a limitation? Watch especially for: applying one leadership slogan universally without evidence about task, people, power, culture, and constraints.
